Every logged in member will see the members homepage. It is designed to surface relevant content to the user, increase engagement, and allow for easier access to what matter most.

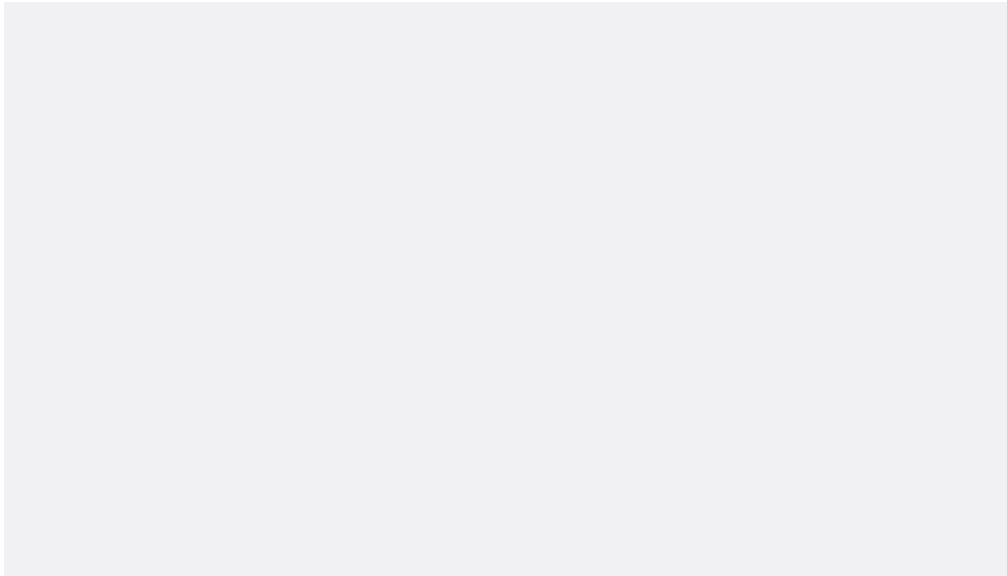
The members homepage has the following goals:

- Potentially show relevant content based on member role



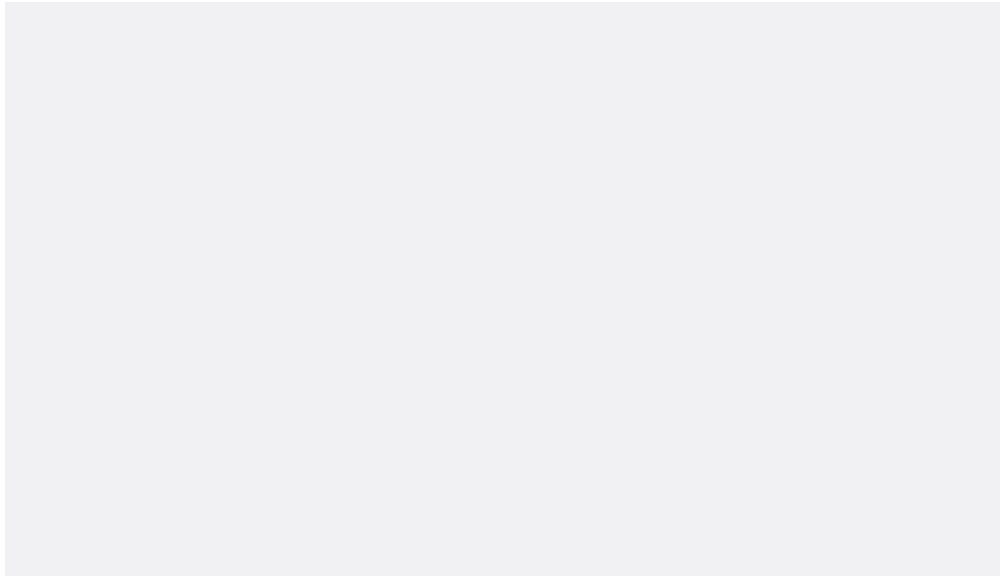
