Hi Ray,  On the homepage of the NYCDH site ( <a href="http://nycdh.org">http://nycdh.org</a> ), there is a link in the welcome text widget that goes to <a href="http://dhweek.nycdh.org">http://dhweek.nycdh.org</a> . As you can see in the attached screenshot, it is an http link, but when I mouse over it in Chrome, it shows as an https link. And when I click on it, it goes, strangely, to a ws.gc.cuny.edu login site, which suggests a redirection problem. do you have any sense of what is going on here?
