**Description**

If a user goes to Settings > Writing to change the default editor from Block to Classic, when they attempt to save these changes they receive the error in the screenshot below. I have tried this myself and two other users have reported the error to me. Any idea what's going on here? Many users (professors) prefer to make the classic editor the default since the block editor is much more confusing for students (and more inaccessible).
