I don't know what web accessibility compliance we're aiming for, but I assume AA. If so, we should use the color #999 for the grey copy. If we'd rather be compliant with AAA, let's use white for all text besides the links. Here are the results for #999, it only fails AAA for normal text (<https://webaim.org/resources/contrastchecker/?fcolor=999999&bcolor=262626>)
