I can reproduce the odd behavior of the off-screen editing panel.

Unfortunately, it looks like the root cause is an incompatibility between the editing tool that social-paper uses (<https://wordpress.org/plugins/wp-front-end-editor/>) and the version of TinyMCE shipped with later versions of WordPress. Fixing this is likely to be non-trivial, and I don't think we have the bandwidth to look into it at this time.

As for the pending comments on this specific paper, there were not 75 (that number was for the entire Commons site), but only about 11. All of them were trackbacks. They seem to be legitimate, so I approved them myself from the WP Dashboard. However, they don't show up on the front-end, probably because social-paper doesn't have any built-in way to show trackbacks (as opposed to regular comments).

Apologies to Erin, but I think this is the best we can do at this time.
