I think this just involves toggling a filter in bbPress to enable TinyMCE. (As a sidenote, I think we already force TinyMCE on in bbPress for CBOX.)

The only remaining issue here is our bbp-live-preview plugin. I did some work earlier in the week to bring bbp-live-preview up-to-date with the latest TinyMCE 4 changes (see [commit b952761](#))

And fixed some minor issues with BPGES while doing some further testing today.

The new cdev environment can be used to test out rich-text forum content in groups. Note: RBE is **not** enabled in new cdev. If you need to test RBE in new cdev, let me know.
