I set up theseegalcenter.org the same as prelude NYC.org to point to 146.96.128.200 but am getting this error:

I just checked. I got the same error at first, but then I did a hard browser refresh (Shift + Refresh) and it then resolved correctly. I'm guessing that this is a case of an aggressive browser cache, affecting those who recently visited the domain at the old address - which is to say that it shouldn't affect most users.

Please try the hard refresh - or try on another machine - and see if you can replicate.
