So from here <http://commons.gc.cuny.edu/groups/itp-core-2-spring-2014/> if I click Blog on the left I get the "You must login..." screen.

Though thinking on it now, maybe this isn't a bug, and maybe I'm the only person who would think to do this! The reason I even try to get to the blog this way is it seems like the fastest way to get there from the homepage if the group is in the recently active groups list but the most recent blog post isn't in the recently active blog list anymore.
