<p>Currently, event-group connections can be created by any group member. This is usually fine, but there may be cases where a member connects an event to a group, but inappropriately. In these cases, group admins should have the ability to remove the connection.</p> <p>Note that this should not require the ability to edit the event in other ways. Probably something as simple as a "Disconnect from group" button, visible to group admins.</p>
