<p>In a blog post written a year ago (<a href="http://help.commonsc.gc.cuny.edu/2010/02/24/how-to-create-blog-subscriptions/">http://help.commonsc.gc.cuny.edu/2010/02/24/how-to-create-blog-subscriptions/</a>), I suggested that that Subscription Options + Feedburner was the best way to create notifications to members of new posts. At the time, we had problems with the Subscribe2 plugin, which creates email alerts for new posts.</p> <p>It appears to me that Subscribe2 is now working, so I think we should do a few things:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>-- Test out Subscribe2 on a test blog to make sure it works for both public and private blogs (I've done this, but would appreciate a second test)</li><li>-- Create a new blog post on the help blog that highlights this functionality</li><li>-- Put an update at the top of the older post linking to the new one</li><li>-- Update the Codex</li></ul> <p>Scott, can you give this a shot?</p>
