Thanks for the ticket!

Have you looked at Jetpack's Post By Email feature? It seems like it might have everything you need: <https://jetpack.com/support/post-by-email/>

The advantages of using Jetpack are (a) it already exists on the Commons, (b) it's very popular, so it's likely that sites are already using it, and (c) it doesn't require any server-level configuration or complex Dashboard-level setup (wordpress.com handles the hard stuff). With this, you could fairly easily set up a forwarding rule on your listserv that goes to your generated post.wordpress.com email address.

Do you think that this might work for you? It's already on the Commons, so you could experiment with it right away.
