Hi All,			
I noticed some responsiveness issues when viewing my Commons profile on my mobile phone (an iPhone). Here is what I noted:			
-- areas of overlapping content			
-- when one starts to scroll and the header snaps up, there are two issues -- 1. it snaps up before one can view all of the text in the header; and 2. In the snapped-up state (sorry -- that's probably not that right term, but I don't know what is), the header takes up more room than it should.			
Please see attached screenshots. I know we are hoping to do a redesign, but I'm hoping that we can address at least a few of these issues in the short term before then.

Dan, can I ask you to take a look? You may need to touch the JS to fix the "snap" point - see <https://github.com/cuny-academic-commons/cac-advanced-profiles/blob/master/assets/js/cacap.js#L55> You should feel free to be liberal in making changes to the appearance of the header in narrow viewers; font size and padding look like they could use some adjustment as well.

Looks like you've already got push access to the repo - feel free to make your changes in a separate branch and then do a PR to master if you'd like a review from me before merging.

I've made some changes that I think should improve the styling and behavior here:

It's hard to tell what CSS changes I made because I un-minified the file, but almost all of them are down at the very bottom in the media queries. Mostly I just reduced some spaces and sizes. I also fixed what I think was a bug, where on screens smaller than 940px you weren't able to see the buttons for saving or canceling your changes. That change was higher up in the sheet - let me know if you have trouble finding it.

The JS change was just to an option passed to a JS plugin to give more scroll-room before the sticky header starts to stick.

I also removed some styling from the bp-nelo stylesheet, in favor of keeping everything in the plugin itself. That change is here:

Do you mind porting your changes to the SASS stylesheet so that they're not lost? (I usually use Compass for SASS processing, but whatever tool you have is OK.)
